

## #TakeHeart Residency Funding 2022 Your Ideas For Working Together

**WHO:** Artist collectives, individual artists like choreographers, dancers, dramaturges, and curators

**DEADLINE:** 21.10.2021

With #TakeHeart, the Fonds Darstellende Künste will continue its comprehensive support measures within the framework of NEUSTART KULTUR, the rescue and future package for culture and media, financed by the German Federal Government Commissioner for Culture and the Media. tanzhaus nrw, as a member of the Alliance of International Production Houses, is pleased to be able to recommend artists for residency funding and is now seeking intense exchange and long-lasting cooperation.

The 2021/2022 season is a special one for tanzhaus nrw: Bettina Masuch commences her final season as artistic director, while Ingrida Gerbutavičiūtė prepares the 2022/2023 season as the future artistic director. There is much to reflect upon, much to get acquainted with, much to shape for the future. Above all, it is important to get to know and to appreciate the artists who currently work at tanzhaus nrw or who wish to work there in the future, and to forge alliances with them.

Therefore, tanzhaus nrw issues an invitation to artist collectives and individual artists like choreographers, dancers, dramaturges, and curators to encounter the tanzhaus nrw team within the scope of a funded residency and to look towards the future together. It is the aim to discuss the work focus at tanzhaus nrw, to deepen it, to consolidate working relationships, and to initiate new ones.

The work focus at tanzhaus nrw lies with regional artists, dance for a young audience, urban dance cultures, dance and digitisation, artists with disability, and diasporic voices in Germany. In this, we wish for questions, impulses and shared space for thought that will be implemented within non-fixed projects such as research projects, laboratories, and conceptions in collaboration with tanzhaus nrw.

### **ABOUT THE PROCESS**

Those interested may follow the invitation until 21.10.2021, communicating their work questions and residency ideas to tanzhaus nrw. To do this, please send a short specification of a maximum of 1,700 characters outlining your residency idea accompanied by a description of your mode of operations of a maximum of 1,500 characters to [TakeHeartResidenzen@tanzhaus-nrw.de](mailto:TakeHeartResidenzen@tanzhaus-nrw.de). You will receive a response by the end of October already. Should we decide on a collaboration, the residency project will be entered, in collaboration with tanzhaus nrw, for a #TakeHeart residency grant at Fonds Darstellende

Künste. Deadline for entering the project with Fonds Darstellende Künste will be 01.12.2021. Applicants will receive support for their submissions from tanzhaus nrw. Handling of all further deadlines on the part of Fonds Darstellende Künste will depend on the responses within the first round. Applicants' submissions do not constitute a legal claim. The decision will be reached without possibility of recourse to legal action.

### **RESIDENCY PERIOD AND AMOUNT OF FUNDING**

Residencies may begin on 01.01.2022, and comprise two consecutive months up until 31.10.2022. Single artists may be granted 5,000 € for a duration of two months, while collectives and groups may receive 5,000 € each for up to five people. It may be possible to prolong the residency period for good reason.
